**Bids must be on standard proposal forms in the manner therein described in the bid documents and be enclosed in a sealed envelope, bearing the name and address of the bidder on the outside, addressed to the Quaker Valley Council of Governments and marked with the project name.**

**Bids must be accompanied by a certified check upon a National or State bank, drawn and made payable without condition to Quaker Valley Council of Governments in an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the bid, or a bid bond of not less than 10%, and be delivered to the place and hour named.**
